Position Announcement

The College of Business at Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) is seeking to appoint an outstanding scholar to the tenure-track position of Associate or Full Professor of Information Systems. The appointment will commence in September 2020 or March 2021. The requirements for this position are as follows: (a) Ph.D. degree in information systems, statistics, industrial engineering, or related fields; (b) an established publication record in top-tier academic journals; and (c) evidence of teaching effectiveness. For the rank of Full Professor, we are seeking an accomplished scholar with an exceptional record of research productivity and a vision to lead the department in expanding its research capability.

KAIST College of Business (KCB) is a graduate-only program, and the successful candidate will be expected to teach graduate-level courses. For new faculty members, the typical teaching load is one course per semester, and each new member will have his or her own research lab. While we will consider candidates with a wide range of interests, the ideal candidate would have an interest in teaching and conducting research in the quantitative and technical areas, including, but not limited to, business/data analytics, artificial intelligence & machine learning, text/image/video mining, and economics of IS.

Located in Seoul, KCB is regarded as one of the leading providers of management and professional education in the Asia-Pacific region and is well known for its academic excellence, high quality research, and innovative programs. KCB is ranked among the Financial Times' top 100 global MBA programs and is accredited by AACSB and EQUIS.
